#### ORDERS BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR OF BENGAL.

No. 24195A.—*The 14th December 1926.*—His Excellency the Governor of Bengal has been pleased to appoint Lieutenant-Colonel S. J. Kendrick, O.B.E., V.D., Commanding the 1st Battalion, the East Indian Railway Regiment, to be an Honorary Aide-de-Camp on his personal staff, *vice* Lieutenant-Colonel W. M. Craddock, resigned.
