APPOINTMENTS AND TRANSFERS.

GENERAL.—No. 985 A.D.—The 26th May 1908.—Babu Braja Durlabh Hajra, Deputy Magistrate and Deputy Collector, Nadia, is transferred to the headquarters station of the Cuttack district.

No. 988 A.D.—The 26th May 1908.—The order of the 12th March 1908, appointing Babu Braja Durlabh Hajra, Deputy Magistrate and Deputy Collector, to have charge of the Jhenida subdivision of the Jessore district, is cancelled.

No. 991 A.D.—The 26th May 1908.—Babu Charu Chandra Mukharji, Deputy Magistrate and Deputy Collector, Cuttack, is appointed to have charge of the Jhenida subdivision of the Jessore district.

DECLARATION.

No. 2264.—*The 2nd June 1908.*—Whereas it appears to the Lieutenant-Governor of Bengal that land is required to be taken by Government, at the public expense, for a public purpose, viz., for the police-station of Morelgunge in the village of Baraikhali, alias Fakirertakia, pargana Silimabad, zilla Khulna, it is hereby declared that, for the above purpose, a piece of land measuring, more or less, 5 bighas 18 cottahs and 1 chitak of standard measurement, bounded on the north by Balainunia or Keri river, on the east by Baraikhali Khal and the Jamai land of Abdul Aziz Shaikh, on the south by the Jamai land of Taripullah and Kasimaddi Shaikh and on the west by a footpath with rows of cocoanut trees leading to the house of Taripullah and Kasimaddi Shaikh and their Jamai lands by its side, is required within the aforesaid village of Baraikhali alias Fakirertakia.

This declaration is made, under the provisions of section 6 of Act I of 1894, to all whom it may concern.
