No. F. 9-1/37-G.—In exercise of the powers
conferred by clause (p) of sub-section (1) of
section 6 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (XV of
1908), the Central Government is pleased to
make the following rules, the same having been
previously published as required by sub-
section (2) of the said section, namely :—

Rules.

1. In these Rules "coasting vessel" means
a vessel trading or otherwise plying between
ports in India only.

2. No coasting vessel or ferry steamer plying
between the Port of Bombay and any other
Indian port which for the time being is within
the Port of Bombay shall leave that port unless
the Master of such coasting vessel or ferry
steamer is in possession of a Deratisation
Certificate or a Deratisation Exemption Certi-
ficate issued not more than six months prior
to the date of departure to the effect that such
coasting vessel or ferry steamer has been
inspected by an accredited Port Health Autho-
