#### NOTIFICATION.

*Calcutta, the 5th November 1912.*

No. 3355M.—Notice is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor will hold a Levee at Government House, Calcutta, at 9-30 P.M. on Saturday, the 21st December 1912.

## NOTIFICATIONS.

*No. 6189.—The 11th November 1912.*—The Governor in Council is pleased to make the following amendments in the revised Code of Regulations for European Schools in Bengal, 1910:—

(i) *Insert* the following as article 108A:—

“108A. In addition to the scholarships enumerated above the following scholarships will be awarded for Jews, Armenians and Parsis who are pupils in recognised European schools:—

*For pupils in Elementary Schools.*

Five scholarships of Rs. 5 a month.

Four scholarships of Rs. 8 a month.

*For pupils in Secondary Schools.*

Four scholarships of Rs. 8 a month for pupils in the Infants' classes and classes I—IV.

Three scholarships of Rs. 10 a month for pupils in classes V—VIII.

Two scholarships of Rs. 15 a month for pupils in classes IX—X.

The scholarships will be awarded for the purposes specified in article 107, and under the conditions set forth in article 108. The Director of Public Instruction may utilise any savings, which may accrue out of unawarded scholarships, in enhancing at his discretion, the value of all, or of some, of these scholarships.”

(ii) *Add* the following to article 101:—

“Certain special scholarships are provided for Jews, Armenians and Parsis in European schools as detailed in article 108A.”

*No. 6205.—The 11th November 1912.*—In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, 1904 (VII of 1904), the Governor in Council is pleased to declare the two ancient temples (joined together) which are situated in the village of Baidyapur in the Kalna subdivision of the district of Burdwan and are bounded as follows, to be protected monuments within the meaning of the said Act:—
